Opportunity Award Scholarship

Each year the Denver A&M Club awards scholarships to incoming freshmen that are residents within the DAMC region through the University's Opportunity Award scholarship program. In 2018, the DAMC will distribute \$6,000 in scholarships to deserving students. The applicant pool determines the number of scholarships given and the specific amounts. Texas A&M University provides the Club with qualified applicants and scholarship recipients are selected by the scholarship committee, which is made up of Club officers. To be considered, complete the general scholarship application through Apply Texas. Applicants must reside in the Club's region and must be admitted to Texas A&M University as a freshman for the Fall 2018 semester. 
Group Meeting, October 2017
