

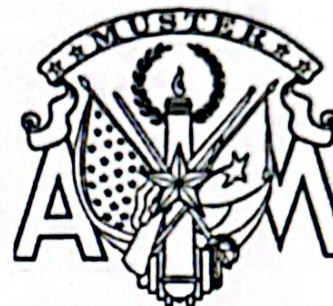

## Aggie Muster 2002

The Texas A&M Club of Denver invites you to our Muster on Sunday, April 21, 2002.

This year's speaker is Billy Pickard '56. He is the *Senior Associate Athletic Director for Facilities*. Mr. Pickard oversees the planning and maintenance of all athletic facilities including the Bernard C. Richardson Zone at Kyle Field, and the new south end zone football and academic complex at Kyle Field.



Muster will be held at the White Fence Farm, 6263 W Jewell Ave. (Between Sheridan & Wadsworth in Lakewood.) Social Hour will begin at 4 PM, supper at 5 PM, followed by the Muster Ceremony.

White Fence Farm is a Denver area tradition serving family style meals in a country atmosphere. There are many family activities, so come early and enjoy the Farm. Here are driving directions to Denver Muster 2002:

### From the north or Downtown:

Take I-25 to W 6th Ave, go West. Take 6th Ave W to S Sheridan Blvd, go left/South. Take S Sheridan Blvd to W Jewell Ave, go right/West. Take W Jewell Ave to 6263 W Jewell on right. Can't miss it!

### From the south or Highlands Ranch:

Take C-470 to S Santa Fe Dr, go North. Take S Santa Fe Dr to W Hampden Ave, go left/West. Take W Hampden Ave to S Sheridan Blvd, go right/North. Take S Sheridan Blvd 2 mi to W Jewell Ave, go left/West. Take W Jewell Ave .5 mi to 6263 W Jewell on right. Can't miss it!

### From the west or Lakewood:

Take C-470 to W Hampden Ave, go East. Take W Hampden Ave to S Sheridan Blvd, go left/North. Take S Sheridan Blvd 2 mi to W Jewell Ave, go left/West. Take W Jewell Ave .5 mi to 6263 W Jewell on right. Can't miss it!

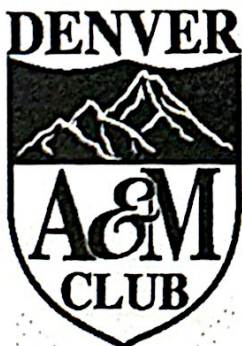
### Happy Hours –April 4<sup>th</sup> at 6:00pm
